A BRIEF HISTORICAL NOTE

The Lord's church here in Queretaro begun in our living-room back in July 1985 with my wife Olivia and our two oldest children present in our first worship service. From zero members and congregations, the church has grown to 15 congregations in the surrounding area. (a list of congregation in given below). The Central School of Preaching (a three-year-program) started back in November 1997, operating under the oversight of the Eisenhower Church of Christ of Odessa, TX. Later on, in 2006, the Crieve Hall Church of Christ of Nashville, TN., stepped in to provide support for the Arroyos and today is one of our main supporters at the school and also in the evangelistic work being done in the area. Just this year, the Crieve Hall brethren started supporting six more evangelists in the area. We praise God for our brethren in Odessa and Nashville and their dedication to mission work!

CONGREGATIONS ESTABLISHED TODAY IN THIS AREA

Just three weeks ago, one more congregation was planted by brethren out of the Peñuelas congregation; they go by Menchaca Church of Christ, and we are providing all the help we can for this new effort. As mentioned above, the Crieve Hall Church of Christ of Nashville, TN. is providing support for many of these mission points.
